Art of Music #1027 - This Art Studio class will focus on the creation of musical instruments using mixed media; paper, cardboard, wood, and plastic. Each student will create and design instruments to perform in a student made orchestra. Students taking this course will learn about the sections of the orchestra (strings, woodwinds, brass, and percussion) the instruments within these sections, and their significance in the orchestra world.

Skill Development - Creative/self-expression, verbal communication, ability to follow step by step directions, research techniques, critical thinking.

Creative Art #1029 - This project based class is for the student who loves to use paper, markers, plastic, cardboard, paint, photography and music to explore different artistic expression. In this class our students will



learn to develop a love of art and design using on their individual creativity. Skill Development - Drawing, creative/self-expression, verbal communication, visual interpretation, ability to follow step by step directions.

Creative Writing #1020 - The emphases in this class will be on developing writing skills and enhancing creativity. There will be group discussions and creative sentence starters to help motivate the students. Creativity and cohesive story development will be the focus of this dynamic course. Skill Development - Reading and reading comprehension, writing, critical thinking, sentence structure, vocabulary, self-confidence, verbal communication.

Drama Workshop #1043 - This class will focus on different types of acting and entertainment. Through music, singing, improvisation and “skits” the students will express their personal creativity and individualism. Skill Development - Creative/self-expression, self-confidence, team membership, critical thinking.

Money Matters #1016 - This course will address money and personal finances. Students will learn basic skills to assist in the handling of money. The topics to be discussed are currency denominations, checking and saving account maintenance, credit and debit cards, successful shopping techniques and a general financial overview of current events. A field trip to a supermarket may be added. Skill Development - Reading and reading comprehension, writing, basic math, currency identification, research techniques.

Mix & Mingle #1039 - This course will focus on the appropriate social behaviors needed to successfully navigate our daily lives. We will discuss how to handle various situations, role play “what if” scenarios and learn strategies for overcoming the complexities of common social etiquette. Skill Development - Critical thinking, social participation, team membership, appropriate social behavior.

Music & Lyrics #1088 - This class is a combination of music and creative writing. Students will listen to music, focusing on the lyrics. They will then use the existing lyrics as starters to adapt their own lyrics, ideas and thoughts to the music. Skill Development- Reading, writing, comprehension, critical thinking, creative/self-expression.

Name that Game #1170 This course will explore the various games, puzzles, and trivia available for healthy competition and teamwork. Students will learn how these games originated and will have the chance to play them as a group. Skill Development - Critical thinking, problem solving skills, following directions, teamwork and verbal communication.

Set Design #1191 - This project based class is designed to work in conjunction with our Drama Workshop. Using paper, markers, plastic, cardboard and paint students will use their individual creativity to design artwork and sets for our Drama Workshop.

Songs of Summer #1037 - This fun music class will focus on songs reminiscent of summer. Vocal warm-ups combined with movement, touch step, sway, arms and hands. Some choreography may be added and adapted to each student’s ability and interest. Skill Development - Research techniques, verbal communication, self-expression, physical coordination.

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
