Course Descriptions

<u>Voices for Change #2091</u> – "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world. Indeed, it is the only thing that ever has." This quote credited to American anthropologist Margaret Mead captures the essence of this inspiring class. Students will learn about the driving forces behind world-changing events and social justice movements from past to present. From the Civil Rights Movement, Americans with Disabilities Act, Gun Violence Awareness, and Bodily Autonomy, we will learn how people have embraced and fought for our founding father's vision of "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness".

Notable and Quotable #2092 — Short and simple, profound or *punny*, quotes are the messages that make us laugh or provoke deep thoughts. This clever class invites students to step into the world of timeless wisdom, exploring the power of quotes and famous sayings across cultures and history. From ancient proverbs to modern expressions, students will learn how to interpret meaning, uncover hidden context, and connect these words to their own lives and writing. <u>Force of Nature #2093</u> – This class will look at the natural forces that shape and affect our planet. From hurricanes, tornadoes, and droughts to forest fires, glaciers, and floods, forces out of our control change the landscape, determine where humans can live, and can cause mass destruction. We will explore these weather phenomena and how each one has affected humans and our environment throughout history.

Students will exchange ideas and share their stories in this fun and creative writing class.
